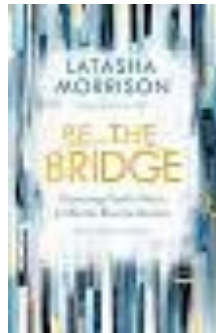




Exciting News from Church Women United Austin
We will be holding our April Forum via Zoom on
April 9, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.



This year's April Forum will be a Gospel-centered conversation on race and the church. The forum will be based on the book, Be the Bridge: Pursuing God's Heart for Racial Reconciliation, by Latasha Morrison. The Forum will include a conversation with Church Women United through Zoom. There will be a virtual breakout session into smaller groups to explore together ways to **facilitate spiritual growth and racial healing**. The April Forum will be led by CWU's Ecumenical Development Coordinator, Linda Ellison.

How can you participate? We will send out a Zoom link in early April. If you haven't already used Zoom, you will need to download a free Zoom app to your computer or phone.

How can you prepare? You can prepare by reading the book. It is available from Christianbook.com for \$10.49 or from Amazon.com for \$8.93.

If you prefer not to purchase the book, the Austin Public Library has 7 copies of the book to download and read, or 9 copies of the audio book. You must have an APL card and an online account to access these books.
