

YOUNG CHURCH WOMEN UNITED AWARD


The **Young Church Women United Award** will be presented at our September 7, 2018 Church *Women United* Meeting which will be held at Memorial United Methodist Church.

My sincere thanks to committee members (Cheryl Banks, Loretta Hill, Carolyn Thompson and Mary Wiley) for a job well done!



CWU MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL CYCLE



Church Women United in Austin relies on your financial support to communicate news about the organization and to fund the Ecumenical Celebrations, Development and Action activities which continue to make us a vibrant, relevant organization. This financial support is given through paid Individual and Fair Share memberships as well as contributions to offerings collected throughout the year.

The normal membership collection cycle is from September 1 through December 31 for the upcoming calendar year. This allows for your information to be published in the

CWU Yearbook that is prepared for distribution in the early months of the upcoming year. In this way, you are paying in advance for your continued membership. For example: If you pay between the beginning of September 2018 through the end of December 2018, you will be paying for your 2019 membership. Your information will be included in the 2019 CWU Yearbook.

When memberships are paid outside of this cycle, payments made from:

- January 1 to June 30 = payment for the current calendar year
- > July 1 to August 31= payment applied to the upcoming calendar year
